Progressing to Key Stage 2, students are then introduced to skills through the exploration of the exciting and engaging DDMIX dance genres which include Japanese, Disco, African, Bollywood and many more.

Activities are used to introduce each genre/skill before sampling our straightforward DDMIX movements giving children creative confidence to make up their own sequences. The children remain high time on task, approaching movement without hesitation and enjoying exercise whilst learning new skills and creating their own ideas.

STAFF TRAINING:

2 hour Inset/Twilight- from £350 4 hour Inset/Twilight- from £550

One of our DDMIX for Schools team members can visit your school school to deliver an inset/twilight session providing the necessary tools and at the same time boosting the confidence of all members of staff regardless of experience and ability.

You will be introduced to the Schemes of Work, cover key skill games and activities used in the lesson plans along with the teaching of at least 3 of the DDMIX genres.

Each training session typically lasts 2 hours, therefore if your school select 4 hours of training (£550), this would be split into two x 2-hour sessions spread across the year. This will enable staff to gain the most out of their training, giving them time to absorb and begin delivery.

Within the second training session, schools can tailor their time to refresh or focus on certain areas e.g., games, skill activities, differentiation, or request additional genres that they'd like to learn or recap.
